




Number of students during last five year



10. TERMINATION:

- 10.1. This Agreement may be terminated at any time during the Term, by mutual consent of Parties in writing.

12. INDEMNITY:





In this direction, through this MoA, the First party(APSSDC) intends to associate with Avanthi Institute of Engineering and Technology to train different segments of students and Job seeking youth in systematic enhancement of Employability Skills towards gainful employment for students / Job seekers;
- (d) The Second Party having been into Educational services through its College by name Avanthi institute of engineering and Technology submitted a proposal to the first party, upon understanding the requirements and functions of proposed 3D-experience Centres (3D-EC). The second party shall ensure adequate furniture, electrical fixtures and Power backup in the class rooms and labs;


